Regarding compliance to the limit values for certain restricted substances in the RoHS directive

Hard metal (sintered carbide) and steel products such as inserts, tools, rods etc., manufactured by Dormer Pramet, are not electrical or electronic components and are intended only for use in Large Scale Industrial Tools or Large Scale Fixed Installations.

Therefore, they are not subject to the EU directive regarding Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).


Nevertheless, we can guarantee that these products are in compliance with the limit values for the restricted substances referred to in Article 4(1) and listed in Annex II of Directive (2011/65/EU) of the European Parliament and of the Council on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS), as amended by **Commission Directives (EU) 2015/863 and 2017/2102**.

By consequence, the products will also comply with the following US legislation:

- 48 CFR 252.223-7008 Prohibition of Hexavalent Chromium and
- Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) clause: 223.7306
