Wetmore Tool & Engineering will strive to provide healthy and safe workplaces. We will continue to reduce injuries and illness and involve our employees in health and well-being activities.


LEGAL COMPLIANCE

Wetmore Tool & Engineering will continue to take a systematic approach to comply with or exceed applicable environmental, health and safety legal and other requirements.


CONTINUAL IMPROVEMENT
